workshops for World Book Day. Many learners have come to school dressed as their favourite book characters, and so have the staff! Some Upper School classes engaged with travel training to


Waterstones book shop to select their preferred book and pay for it with their token. The school is buzzing today with the excitement literature brings to our learning environments.

Camden Special Parents Day


