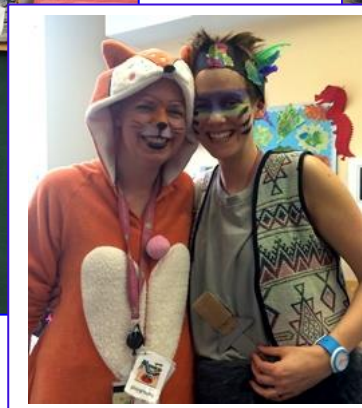
workshop, involving a play called 'Chelsea's Choice' and in writing a review of the play 'An Inspector Calls'.

The week has ended with a day filled with storytelling, reading, sensory, and drama

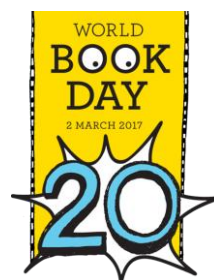
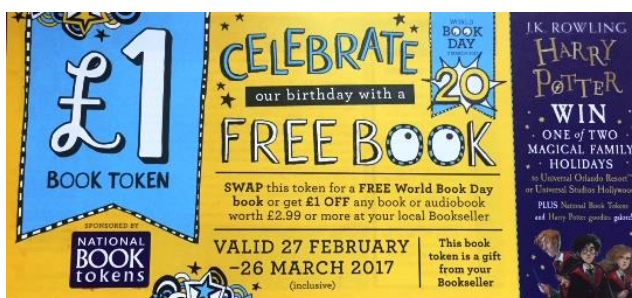


workshops for World Book Day. Many learners have come to school dressed as their favourite book characters, and so have the staff! Some Upper School classes engaged with travel training to
