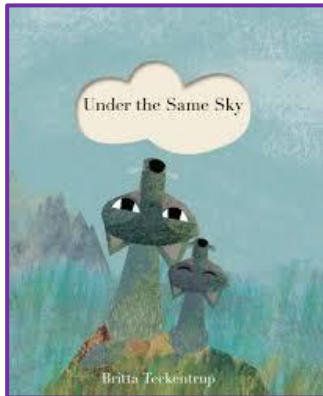
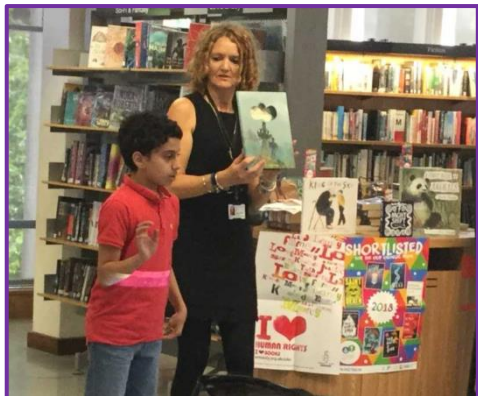
Partnership with 'Give together' Charity
