It was lovely to catch up with Andrew and he enjoyed working with pupils at his former school.

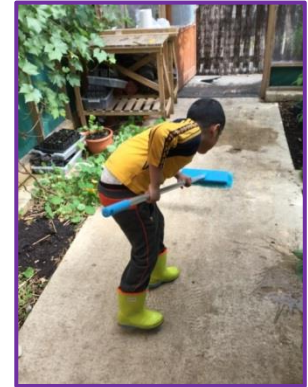


Lower School students have been learning about growing food and also getting plenty of 'hands-on experience' in the school's greenhouse and garden.
