Saddlers Wells Performance

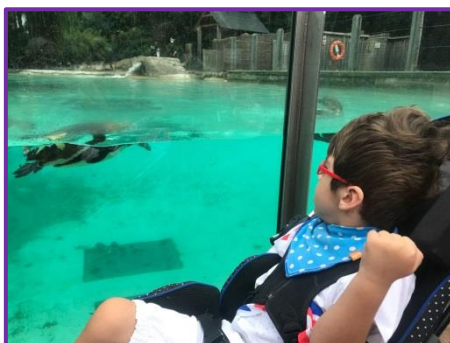
