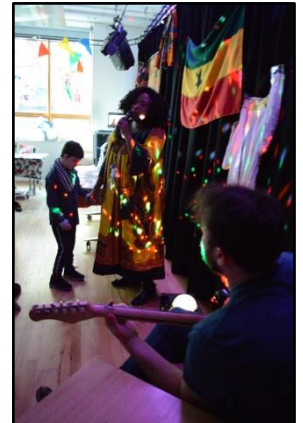
Dear Parents, Carers, and Families,

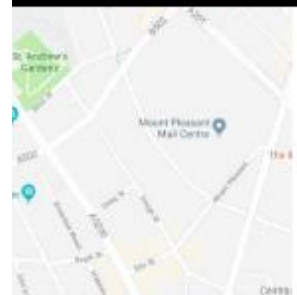
