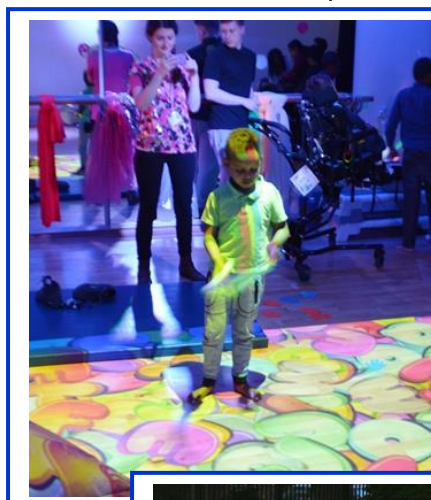


Weekly Newsletter 5th May 2017
